WHEREAS, the Arizona Women's Partnership, Inc., a non-profit organization, was formed to assist Arizona grass roots charities which help underserved women and children at risk; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Women's Partnership created a multi-cultural committee to solicit and review grant applications, as well as organize the annual fundraising event; and



WHEREAS, Dr. Emily Cutrer, Dean of the New College of Interdisciplinary Arts and Sciences, and Dr. Astair Mengesha, Chair of ASU West Women's Studies Department, graciously invited AWP to showcase their photography exhibition in the Fletcher Library to celebrate Women's History month on the ASU West campus; and

WHEREAS, the fifth annual Wine, Women and Jazz fundraiser, will be presented on Sunday, May 28.


