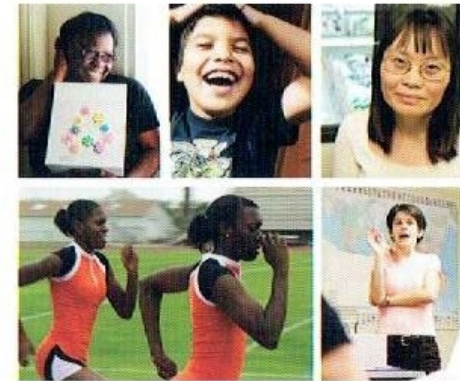

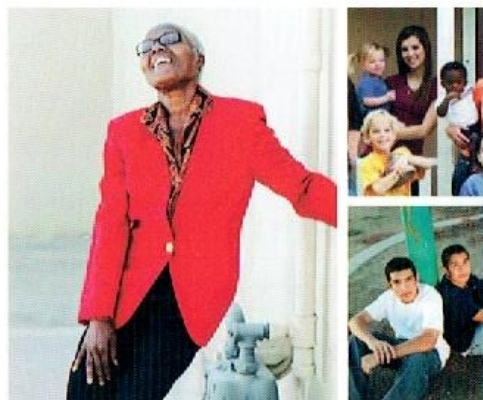

In the words of Paula Cullison, founder of the Arizona Women's Partnership, "We come together, each in our own way, to make a difference in the lives of others."

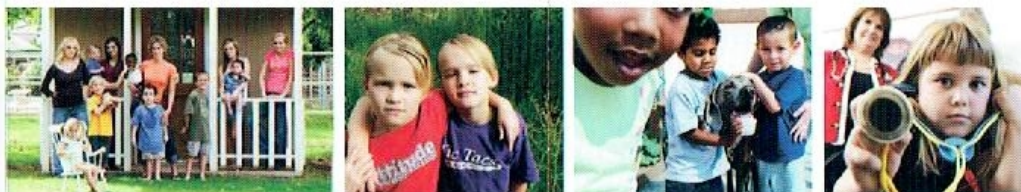
